

TOWN OF WOLCOTT PUBLIC HEARING

The Council of the Town of Wolcott met Tuesday, July 18, 2017 at 6:00 pm, in the Community Room of the Wolcott Town Hall for a Public Hearing to provide interested citizens and taxpayers an opportunity to express their views on the proposed Ordinance No. 2017-12, An Ordinance Amending the Billing Cycle, Flat Assessment Fee and Parcel Considerations of Ordinance No. 2013-03 An Ordinance Amending the Stormwater Assessment Fee in Accordance with Wolcott Town Ordinance No. 2010-02, An Ordinance to Establish the Fee to Provide Revenue to the Stormwater Fund.
