

TOWN OF WOLCOTT COUNCIL MEETING

The Council of the Town of Wolcott met Tuesday, March 20, 2012 at 6 pm in the Community Room of the Wolcott Town Hall for its regular stated meeting. Present were President Marsha L. Mackey, Vice President Jon H. Evans, Council members Richard A. Lynn, Fred A. Young and Michael A. Yelton, Deputy Clerk Merri K. Schieler, Town Attorney Mark L. Callaway, Wolcott Wastewater Supt. Chad W. Reynolds. Also present were residents Daryl Orns, Jim Britt and Barbara Lawson of *The New Wolcott Enterprise*.

Council President Marsha Mackey opened the meeting by asking all present to join in saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

She then asked if there were any questions or comments from the audience. Mr. Britt stated he had concerns about the charges for stormwater. Mr. Britt has ten lots and wanted to know if he was going to have to pay stormwater charges. Council is still looking at the ordinance and is waiting on comment from Linda S. Bajzatt, Clerk-Treasurer. Deputy-Clerk Merri Schieler stated there were 529 parcels in the Town of Wolcott and is currently billing for 430.

Daryl Orns stated how nice it was to walk the sidewalks along Highway 24 without fear of tripping. Mr. Orns stated it would be nice if some of the side street sidewalks could be improved. Council President Marsha Mackey stated that the council has been looking into starting a program for sidewalk replacement.

Departmental reports were then given:

Wastewater Supt. Chad W. Reynolds stated that the plants should start producing hot patch at the end of this week. He asked if council wanted him to go purchase bags of patch to fix the holes. Council told Mr. Reynolds to wait until the plant is in production.

Wastewater Supt. Chad W. Reynolds stated the control panel for the lift station came in last week. Randy Bonty of Fluid Thermal should be installing at the first of next week. Council member Richard Lynn told Mr. Reynolds that they would like him there during installation.

Wastewater Supt. Chad W. Reynolds asked if they could have the reeds removed from the pond. This time of the year is best. They also had an IDEM inspection and the inspector suggested that they remove them. Council advised Mr. Reynolds to get more than one quote to the cost of removal.

Wastewater Supt. Chad W. Reynolds stated they jetted the tile by Darren Fosters.

Wastewater Supt. Chad W. Reynolds asked if it was okay for Mr. Robert Thomas to attend the IRWA conference in Columbus. The council stated that was fine.

Wastewater Supt. Chad W. Reynolds brought a list of streets that they feel need attention. They are getting quotes from Town and Country, Extreme, and Central Paving. Mr. Reynolds said they had talked to some other town and they use only INDOT certified contractors to make sure they

are getting the job done to proper specs. Council asked Mr. Reynolds to see if the contractors INDOT certified. Council also told Mr. Reynolds to get quotes for the alley between Market and Johnson streets also. Council wants the quotes lined itemed and want them at the next board meeting. Council also told Mr. Reynolds to take pictures of the streets that have the cracks he talked about.

Council asked if the water drains any better at the end of Fourth Street. Mr. Reynolds stated it still holds water if we get rain. Council advised Mr. Reynolds to measure how far it would be to take drainage to the north to South Street.

Wastewater Supt. Chad W. Reynolds stated that Deichman is schedule to be back in town April 1 and plan to be done by April 15. There was discussion if they could get everything done and cleaned up in that amount of time. Council wants a final review of properties before the project is done.

Council President Marsha Mackey asked if the town employees were going to start spraying for mosquitos soon. Mr. Reynolds said the sprayer had to be certified and thoroughly cleaned before they could start. Council told Mr. Reynolds they were to get this done as soon as possible.

Council Member Richard Lynn said they should be getting electric put out to the new garage.

Old Business

Council President Marsha Mackey asked Attorney Mark Callaway if he had the resolution prepared for the property on 129 West Market. He said it was done but he felt he needed to change some of the wording. Mr. Callaway said he would have it done this week and would email it to Linda or Merri. Marsha Mackey stated they wanted to sign it at their March 27, 2012, meeting next week.

Council member Michael A. Yelton moved to accept the minutes and memoranda as read:

Council Member Fred A. Young seconded the motion; and the motion passed 4-0.

Council Member Michael A. Yelton told the council that there was going to be a meeting of the Main Street Committee on Thursday, March 22, 2012 to discuss the results of the March 8, 2012 meeting. The entire council was welcome to come.
